

Official Minutes of  
Moe Twp Board of Supervisors  
October 2, 2017

The meeting was called to order by Bushard. All members of the Board were in attendance except Fred Krafthefer. The POA was given.

A motion was made to approve the agenda as modified to add Spraying Neiland's Lilac Bushes and Washing Out Orval Wevley's Driveway to New Business. (m- John Krafthefer, s- Lynn Bushard)

A motion was made to approve the minutes from the September 5<sup>th</sup> meeting. (m- Lynn Bushard, s- John Krafthefer)

## OLD BUSINESS

### Road Report

Kevin's been mowing and grading working on ditches on Moe Hall Road. Dean Anderson who was a blade operator in Southern MN spent a little time with Kevin showing him a few tricks/tips on grading.

### Pheasant Drive & County Ditch 22 Update

Moe Township and Brandon Township who got a quote from Chuck Olson to clean out the ditch from County 7 to Clay Johnson's driveway for \$1,200 if the townships want to have it done. Bushard talked to Tom Anderson who had just completed a survey on the ditch which showed that there was 2 feet of fill above grade in the ditch along Martin's property on County Road 56. Tom Anderson said that the County plans to put a 48 inch culvert in Martin's field road and he will be going in front of the County Commissioners on October 3<sup>rd</sup> to get approval to clean and repair this. If the County agrees with the cleaning and repairing the cost will be a 3 way split between the County, the ditch and the Townships (Moe and Brandon).

### Gravel Update

We called for more gravel on Valley Lane.

### Tree Trimming Update

Bushard is checking to see what needs to be trimmed. We still need to figure out how many trees to remove on the the curve on Pioneer Park by Pommerenke's.

### Fish Lake Trapping Update

Since John Stone does not want to be trapping beavers here for the reasons he explained last month we hired a professional trapper. We got Matt Anderson in there to remove the beavers. He's asking \$60 per beaver and so far he has caught 6. A motion was made to retain Matt Anderson as our trapper and to pay him \$60 per beaver. (m- John Krafthefer, s- Lynn Bushard)

### Shamrock Lane Vacate Easement Update

Bushard talked to the surveyor who wants at least \$2,000 probably a little more to do the surveying and the paperwork. He will survey a hammer handle turn-around in if we vacate the end of the road.

## NEW BUSINESS

### Second Snow Plow Operator

Bushard will talk to Shane to see if he is interested in being the second snow plow operator this winter.

### LP Gas Contract

We would like to contract with Hiway Amoco at \$1.19 which requires a \$.10 per gallon down payment on the number of gallons we want to contract for. We used about 1,800 gallons last year.

### Tiling Permits

Bushard prepared tiling permits for Jerry Morical and Richard Klimek.

### Spraying of Kyle Neiland's Bushes

Kyle Neiland feels that we sprayed and killed about 75 feet of lilacs on his properties. We should wait until next spring to see if they come back or if they are truly dead. We purchased Commando and LV6 for chemicals. Bushard will ask Kevin what he used in that area.

### Orval Wevley Driveway Washing Out on Moe Hall Road

Orval has had a lot running down the tar then off the tar washing out a driveway to his garage. Bushard will stop over and look at it to see if we should put crushed rock or something else in there.
