

MOE TOWNSHIP SNOW PLOW POLICY

Plowing shall commence at the discretion of the Primary Equipment Operator and/or the Township Supervisors, but not before a minimum of three (3) inches of snow accumulation has occurred on unpaved roads. Paved roads will be plowed after an accumulation of two (2) inches of snow. Start time may vary due to weather event conditions. With afternoon or evening snowfalls the normal start time shall be 4:00 AM. Freezing rain and blowing and drifting snow events may also cause equipment to be dispatched at varying times. Equipment operator and traveling public safety will be the primary concern, and every effort will be made to minimize equipment breakdown. In cases of a heavy snowfall of four (4) inches or more, plowing will initially be concentrated with the opening up of one lane on all roads. After all the initial openings have been completed, equipment will return to widen the roadways, move recently drifted-in snow and cleanup turn-arounds and cul-de-sacs.

Brandon Twp. Will plow on even numbered years and Moe Twp. Will plow on odd numbered years. A year will run from December 1 of one year through November 30 of the following year. To determine the odd vs even for a “plowing year”, the year in which eleven (11) months fall will constitute the “plowing year”.

MISC. POLICY STIPULATIONS

- 1) This policy may be changed or modified at any time by the Township Board of Supervisors, or in an emergency by the Primary Equipment Operator.
- 2) The Board of Supervisors has ordered that there be no private driveway or parking lot plowing using township equipment.
- 3) The Board of Supervisors has ordered that the Equipment Operators not become involved with the towing or pulling of any non-township vehicles. The only exception to this order is that Equipment Operators may assist a stranded motorist where personal safety is involved.
- 4) Sand/salt applications are to be made at all stop sign controlled intersections whenever slippery conditions exist. Otherwise mixture applications will be at the discretion of the Road Equipment Operators and/or the Township Supervisors.
